To be eligible as cases of "Big Push for Sustainability", studies must report at least one indicator of each dimension of sustainable development (economic, social, and environmental) which are detailed in the rules of the present call.

Visibility

All studies eligible as cases of Big Push for Sustainability will be part of a **REPOSITORY**.

The most transformative case studies towards socioeconomic and environmental sustainability will be **RECOGNIZED** in a publication, which is planned to be presented at a parallel event at the UNFCCC COP25 in Santiago, Chile.
