MORES

- MORES stands for "Modeling Report on Expenditure Statistics"
- MORES is a structured format which allows data compilation for GDP on the expenditure side, at the disaggregated level needed for PPP estimation
- El MORES is made up of 9 spreadsheets
 - ▶ 2 spreadsheets which correspond to the cover and notes
 - 3 spreadsheets which should be completed with information for the last year available
 - 3 spreadsheet which should be completed with the information for 2017
 - 1 spreadsheet which contains parameters





GDP by Basic Heading

- ► The countries are kindly asked to complete GDP information at the 155 basic heading level, for the last year available as well as for 2017
- Disaggregation of the 155 basic headings:
 - ▶ 110 Individual Consumption Expenditure By Households
 - ▶ 31 Government Consumption (individual y collective)
 - ▶ 13 Gross Capital Formation
 - ▶ 2 Balance of Exports and Imports
