
## The Bahamas National Accounts

Operations despite lockdowns

- •1<sup>st</sup> lockdown approx. two (2) months (March 20<sup>th</sup> – May 11<sup>th</sup>)
- Department of Statistics offices closed completely during the first lockdown.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> lockdown August 2020
- 3<sup>rd</sup> lockdown Oct 8<sup>th</sup> 2020





## Working Remotely

- •Limited Ability (Required Govt laptop/VPN Access)
- •Only the National Accounts Supervisor and Unit Coordinator had remote access
- During the lockdown staff were only able to participate in virtual meetings (reviewed data prior to public release)
