


Census 2010 Provisional Population and Households, by Sex and Districts



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Ageing in Belize

- Population Estimate 2016: 377,968
- ❖ Approximately 6.1% (19,808) of our population is older persons. This figure increases by 1,200 annually.
- ❖ Diabetes (14.4%) and Hypertension(18.3%) (high blood pressure) are the two most common chronic illness experienced by older people in Belize
- ❖ There are 3 main residential facilities in Belize. These 3 facilities have less than 100 residents. Two private residential institutions also exist. within the Belize District. Older persons in Belize are living in communities..
- ❖ 34% of older persons are living in poverty (2010 CPA)
- ❖ 61% of older persons in Belize do not receive a pension or monthly income from a pension scheme. (2010 Study towards a Universal Pension)
