

- Objective: Strengthen geospatial information management governance and policies
- Major Results:
 - Efficient planning & coordination
 - Strengthened leadership & political buy-in
 - Cooperative data sharing environment
 - Shared understanding of integrated geospatial information management

Track 3: Collaboration and partnerships



- Support efforts of multiple countries in the Caribbean
- Major Results:
 - Effective cooperation across disciplines & sectors
