






General concepts - CSEC


The Care Economy according to Law 1413 of 2010, refers to the unpaid work done in the household that is related to the maintenance of the household, the care of other people in the household or the community and the maintenance of the strength of remunerated job. This category of work is of fundamental economic importance in a society.

Replacement cost methodology consists of estimating the cost that the household would have to incur to acquire care services, that is, looking for the price that the household would have to pay in the event that services produced by the TDCNR were not provided, which changes depending on the salary chosen to make the valuation.






Production account

Production account

- The TDCNR is an output for own final use.
- Although the SNA recommends using basic market prices, since there are no reliable prices, the value of production is considered equal to the sum of its production costs (SNA 2008, 6.125).


Economic value of the TDCNR



Economic value of the TDCNR compared to the added value of the most representative groups of activities of the Colombian economy (current prices)






Value of the production of domestic and unpaid care work (TDCNR) compared to the value of the production of the other institutional sectors of the Colombian economy (current prices)

Gross value added TDCNR 2017


Percentage share of the added value of domestic and unpaid care work (TDCNR)/the extended added value of the Colombian economy










TDCNR hours by functionality according to geographic class 2017




It is observed that the supply of food and the maintenance of clothing reach a greater participation in the total hours dedicated to TDCNR by women, in the dispersed rural and populated centers, in comparison with the Municipal centres.

In 2017, the total hours dedicated to TDCNR in Colombia by the population aged 10 years and above was 36.508.827 thousand hours, this total of hours was done by 88.5% of women and 58.4% of men





Average hours of weekly dedication By educational level

Regarding the educational level, for the functionality of food management and preparation it is found that those who have reached basic elementary school at the most, the average weekly hours of dedication is:

- Women 17,3
- Men 8,6

The highest value by this functionality for both sexes.




Average hours of weekly dedication By age groups

The functionality of food management and preparation shows a growing trend with age, where in the case of women between 10 to 18 years old is 6,7 hours, and in the group between 49 and 60 years old it reaches to 16,9 hours.

In the case of men, it rises from 3,7 hours in the group aged 10 to 18 years to 8,9 hours for those aged 60 or over.








Annual hours worked by the PET* in job SNA, TDCNR and total Million hours - Average 2016-2019p





Annual hours worked by the PET in TDCNR (Labor market situation) Million hours - Average 2016-2019p
