- CYEN has over **800** members and conducts operations in **20** countries within the wider Caribbean region.



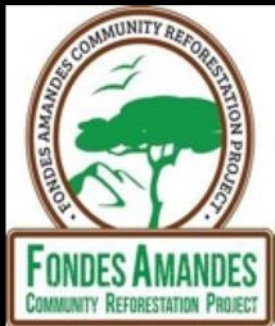


The CYEN focuses on **promoting** and **facilitating** youth engagement and participation through education and awareness, as well as advocacy and lobbying about fundamental issues.
