Elements that can lead to the successful production of climate change and disaster statistics (1/3)

1. Collaboration of stakeholders and government agencies/data providers 2. Establishment of National Environment Working Groups 3. Metadata and methodology training

Interagency Collaboration, Gaps Assessments

inter agency coordination common technical language of relevant stat domain

Co-ordination between the NSO and other agencies involved in the collection and compilation of environment data. Political will and support to compile environment indicators More human resources for the NSO and relevant agencies involved in environment

Developing a close working relationship with both private and public sector having stakeholders sessions to bring out the importance of the indicators

collaboration amongst statistics providers, good data, disaggregated statistics

Elements that can lead to the successful production of climate change and disaster statistics (2/3)

Collaboration, cooperation and coordination between departments and agencies.

Agreements on metadata

Interagency/ inter-unit sharing; institutional capacity

Collaboration with line ministries and agencies Staff training Best practices

A good understanding of the value and benefits of the data collected

strengthening NNs training coordination between agencies

Integrate various ministries and organizations, rely on evidence-based research, use existing archived records

Documented and Agreed Institutional Arrangements

reduce the reporting burdens

Coordination across National and regional agencies Human and financial capacity
Adherence to international framework and methodologies

Standard formats for data collection and entry which are shared with stakeholders

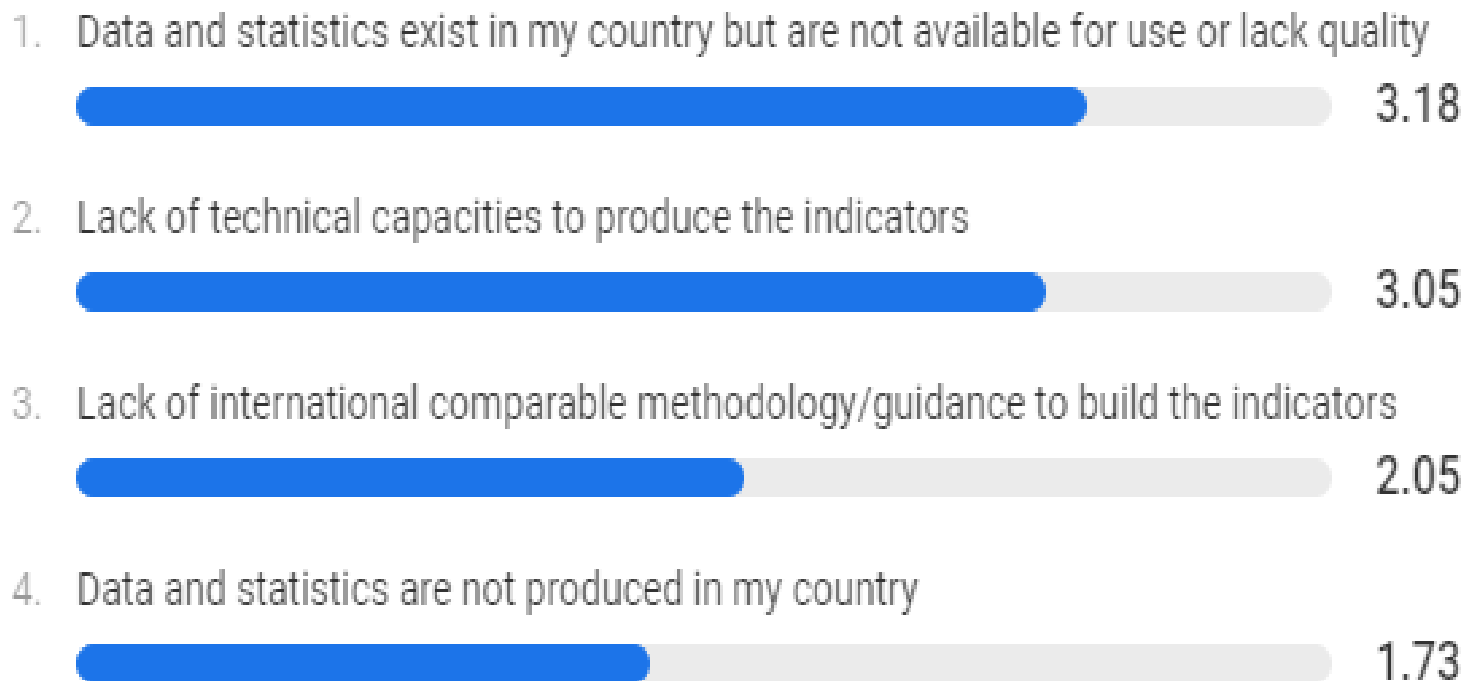
