The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 is the global roadmap for reducing human and economic loss as a direct result of disasters.

 Every \$1 invested in risk reduction and prevention can save anywhere up to \$15 in post-disaster recovery.




Sendai Framework Monitoring (SFM)

In order to measure global progress in the implementation of the Sendai Framework, a set of indicators was developed by an **open-ended intergovernmental expert working group (OIEWG) on indicators and terminology relating to disaster risk reduction**, established by the United Nations General Assembly resolution 69/284 in June 2015.

On 1 December 2016, the United Nations General Assembly **adopted the report of the OIEWG** containing a set of **38 indicators recommended for the seven targets of the Sendai Framework**.

In order to facilitate the reporting, and in compliance with the recommendations of the OIEWG, the United Nations Office for Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR) made available to Member States the online Sendai Framework Monitoring (SFM) System on 1 March 2018, and a set of Technical Guidance Notes for reporting on the Sendai Framework.


