## ICP Approach: housing surveys

There are two forms to report the data necessary to calculate the PPPs for housing services according to the two PCI methods:

1. Rental survey (price approach): collects information on actual rentals (annual averages) for properties with different characteristics. The form asks for: (1) annual rental amount, (2) size of the house in m 2 ; and (3) annual rental price per m2.
2. Volume survey (quantity approach): collects the total number of dwellings in the country. This information is required broken down by: (1) type of dwelling (house or apartment) and (2) location (urban or rural areas).

## The first thing is to read the page with the instructions of the form, which includes all the definitions.

Dwelling size (usable space) refers to the floor area of living rooms, kitchens, utility rooms, shower rooms, bathrooms, toilets and halls, minus the wall thickness and door and window recesses. Stairs, open balconies and terraces are not included. In the case of attics and cellars, only the habitable area should be included.
Dwelling size (usable space) is to be provided in square meters $\left(\mathrm{m}^{2}\right)$; dwelling size in sqft is provided for reference only.

Electricity is usually generated by power stations, which use various fuel sources, or it can be generated by the household itself from a diesel or gasoline generator, solar panels or wind power.
Inside water refers to having water supply that is piped into the dwelling itself or piped from an underground spring or well that is for the exclusive use of the household.
Private toilet and kitchen are for the exclusive use by the occupants of the dwelling unit and have running water.

Annual rent is to be reported in Local Currency Units (LCU) and should reflect the annual average.
Annual rent per $\mathrm{m}^{2}$ can be calculated as "Annual rent" divided by "Dwelling size in $\mathrm{m}^{2}$."

## Frequently Asked Questions

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## Can I include monthly rental prices?

No. The form asks for annual rental prices, not monthly.

## Can I include only one observation per type of dwelling?

No. The form requires national averages. For example, the annual rental price for a single-family home ( $90-120 \mathrm{m2}$ ) should be the national average for a single-family home (90-120 m 2 ) in the country.

Can I include rental prices in square feet?
No. The form requires rental prices in square meters (m2). Square feet to m2 conversion is included in the specification for reference only.
