1. Promotion and implementation of standards

This process seeks to promote and provide information on the use of and compliance with quality requirements in all stages of the statistical process, through permanent mechanisms and instruments aimed at improving the quality of the statistical process. This is developed by two teams:



Quality promotion workshops



Their purpose is to promote and provide information on quality assurance of statistical operations produced within the NSS.

Quality promotion workshops with **29 statistical operations of DANE** were held between August and December 2014; 62 professionals from different fields attended the workshop.

Quality promotion workshops with **3 NSS entities** and **5 statistical operations** of DANE's National Accounts directorate were held between June and September 2015; 96 professionals attended the workshop.



Campaign for the socialization and dissemination of statistical standards.

A dissemination strategy to publicize the NSS and its coordination instruments including statistical standards. During 2015, 120 people of the defense and education sectors, among others, participated in the socialization process. This process has extended to areas such as the metropolitan area of Medellin, Bucaramanga, Pasto and the Amazon.





The following activities for promoting the utilization of standards and guidelines have been carried out:

32 Workshops on methodological documentation.

8 Workshops on microdata management tools and the ANDA.

3 Virtual workshops on microdata management tools.

10 NSS awareness-raising activities; 8 within the framework of the campaign.

8 SDMX workshops (2014-2015).

12 Nomenclatures and classifications workshops (2014-2015).

- International statistics institutes such as: the National Statistics Institute-INE of Spain, the National Institute of Statistics and Geography- INEGI of México, the National Statistics Institute- INE of Chile; and multilateral agencies such as the World Bank, the Statistical Office of the United Nations, the Inter-American Development Bank, The United Nations Population Fund-UNFPA, the International Organization for Migration - IOM, UNESCO, The Pan American Health Organization (PAHO), The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) and international experts.
- 37 independent international subject-matter experts who have participated in various assessment processes.

NSS statistical operations have improved in the following aspects:



Integrity and consistency of databases and timely dissemination of results with respect to the period in which the phenomenon is being measured. Moreover, historic series started to be disseminated and access to microdata is provided.



Emphasis on the needs of major users and development of new ways to contact them and increase their participation in technical committees



Implementation of nomenclatures and classifications.
