

Population and housing census according to administrative records: Our utopia as a driving force




The benefits of switching from the traditional PHC to a PHC based on administrative records

Traditional Population and Housing Census	Population and Housing Census based on administrative records	Benefits of census based on administrative records
Every 10 years	Ongoing	Greater opportunity
Intermediate years are based on projections	Permanent real data	Better input for planning and reallocating resources
The information is gathered by interviewers (students)	Information gathered at source (legal base)	Better quality
High cost for the State every 10 years	Initial phase + maintenance costs	Less expensive in the medium term



Where do we live? With whom do we live?




Individuals

The Galápagos Islands were declared a World Heritage site by UNESCO in 1978. This makes them a sensitive and protected ecosystem.




Building the Residence Registry

What are the main challenges?

- 1. Institute a **statistical culture** in Ecuador.
- 2. Instill a sense of citizen duty by means of the incentives system.
- 3. Guarantee the **individual freedoms** set forth in the Constitution.
- 4. The vast majority of Ecuadorian municipalities **do not have quality land registries**.
- 5. Non-existence of a **unique land registry code** among the 221 cantons of Ecuador.
- 6. Interconnection and interoperability of databases.
- 7. Institutionalization of administrative records.
