ADVANTAGES OF ADAPTING



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INSTEAD OF ADOPTING OR BUILDING IT FROM ZERO

- Capitalizing the professional and institutional experience in training of several National Statistical Offices and International Organizations
- Increasing commitment for horizontal cooperation, combined with fruitful inter-institutional cooperation in the Region
- The flexibility, economies of scale and community construction that will mean working in network for training, sharing training HHRR and physical and technological infrastructure, and financial resources savings
- The possibility of regional and national courses, using common infrastructure

- Our proposal from ECLAC: build a interinstitutional training network with countries and regional and international organizations
- Beginning with:
 - 1. Survey Skills Development Course, and
 - 2. The Business and Economic Statistics Training
