

Questionnaire results for regional priorities: HIGH AND MEDIUM PRIORITY

<u>Gender</u>

- Strengthen the cross-cutting gender focus in the production, development and dissemination of statistics in the NSS ("leave no one behind") for the monitoring of gender equality
- Maintain the link between the set of prioritized indicators at the regional level and the regional commitments of the Regional Gender Agenda
- Strengthen the methodological work of time use surveys, surveys of violence against women, measurement of femicide, among others
- Strengthen inter-institutional alliances between producers and users
