2018 UN-GGIM EIGHTH SESSION

The IGIF and its Overarching Strategic Framework is adopted, first Member State begins implementation

2019 WORK BEGAN DA-11 PROJECT

Burkina Faso, Ethiopia, Fiji, Mongolia, Nepal and Tonga begin implementing IGIF

2020 UN-GGIM TENTH SESSION

IGIF Implementation Guide is adopted and the formation of the HLG-IGIF is approved

FEBRUARY 2021 HLG-IGIF forms and holds first virtual meeting

- Mobilize needed resources for implementation and to maintain the momentum and evolving refinement of the IGIF with Member States and other key stakeholders





Widespread Engagement IGIF Featured at the 2nd World Geospatial Information Congress:


